SILENT DISCO MANUAL



Overview

The idea of a Silent Disco is to let the guest choose what they listen to whilst dancing in their own world. They could be dancing with friends with absolutely no clue of what their friends are listening to. This works over a Cloud mic mixer as this allows any mic or music to be played through the separate channels on the headphones, this can also access the room's PA system thus allowing the entertainers complete freedom of what music is being played through whatever playback device.

Equipment

Headphones

Transmitter adaptors for the transmitters (one in use, one back up)

- Cables (to connect to phono or stereo audio source)

AAA Batteries

2 Audio Sources – laptop/MP3/iPod

Format

PR your event to ensure everyone is aware of what is going on prior to it beginning.

As the 'DJ' for this event, hand out the head sets and explain before pressing 'play':

"On your headphones that I have given you there are some buttons you need to know. Channel A is DJ one, Channel B is DJ 2 and off turns it off! The volume wheel controls the level of volume you can hear, please don't play the songs too high as it could damage your ears. If you want to mute the headphones press the monitor button!"

"Are we ready? Let's party!"

Facilitate the session by keeping track of what the guests are listening to, and judging whether there is any specific points of audience interaction... time for a party dance?"

Once the session has come to an end, ensure that you retrieve all headsets and tidy them away properly as per the checklist below.

Preparation and Information

Ensure your equipment is functional prior to the event.

The Transmitter broadcasts both of the channels available to a range of 100m.

Load up two different Live Business Silent Disco Mixes to your audio sources.

Connect your two audio sources to your transmitter with the audio cables.

Having connected your two audio sources, you can then connect the power to the transmitter.

Preparation and Information

The headphones have 3 different channels.

1. *DJ one* is audio source 1
2. *DJ two* is audio source 2
3. *OFF* Turns the headset off.

There is a volume control which allows you to individually control your own headphone volume.

There is a monitor button which mutes the headphones when it is pressed.

The headphones will display a green light when they are working and fully receiving a signal. A red light indicates that there is no signal being received and no light means the headphones are turned off or they have ran out of battery. A fainter coloured light and lower sound levels indicate the batteries are low and in need of changing. PLEASE ENSURE YOU TURN OFF THE HEADPHONES AFTER USE.

Packdown Guidelines

- Prepare empty box with foam in place
- ENSURE HEADPHONES ARE TURNED OFF
- Pack the headsets away in pairs
- Create five 'stacks' of pairs of headphones
- Add pairs to the stacks, so as to create even layers.
- When you have five layers this will total 50 headsets, which is the total amount.
- Close the lid gently.
